Function

- 1. SCART inputs 1 8
- 2. SCART outputs A B
- 3. Discrete audio output 4. LED screen
- 5. LED contrast adjustment
- 6. Reset and Input Selector buttons
- 7. Wi-Fi module and antenna
- 8. Communication connectors
- 9. Expansion port





The current Wi-Fi operation mode will be displayed, followed by the Host Name and then the IP address.



The default Host and IP Address on the first start is gcswitch and 192.168.4.1

Once initialization is complete, the default idle screen is displayed.

Modes

The switch operates in Automatic or Manual modes. When in Automatic mode, the switch will automatically detect an input signal and turn on the active port. When in Manual mode, the switch will latch to the selected port, regardless if there's an input signal or not, and will ignore any other port activity.

Changing modes

Modes can be changed in two ways: By pressing the input selector button the switch or via the web App.

To switch modes on the switch, press the IO0 button, on the right.



For every press, the switch will select the next port in the chain. Once all ports have been selected, the switch will turn back to Automatic mode.

Alternatively, when in Manual mode, keep the IOO button pressed for 5 seconds and the switch will return to Automatic mode.

Controlling the switch with your phone

The Games Care Smart RGB Switch can be controlled with your phone via the web App.

The web App runs directly from the switch, and no download is required. To get started you first need to connect to the switch.
